## Presentation Requirements

All works must be original. The artist is responsible for delivering the art as well as picking it up following the exhibit. Works do not need to be framed, but should come with the required hardware (magnets, clips, etc.) Traditional framed artwork must be ready to hang with wire. Identification labels with artist name and title should be attached to the back of the work.

Old South Church is not liable for damage or loss of works at the event.

All artwork must include a completed submission form (*below*).
